



Admission Policies and Procedures

Bristow Academy Inc. will admit students without regard to sex, race, national origin, sexual orientation or handicap unless otherwise restricted by the Federal Aviation Administration's regulations.

Admission Requirements

The following are admission requirements for enrollment at Bristow Academy.

- Minimum age is 17 for Private Pilot Program (*note: must turn 18 before starting other programs*)
- Ability to read, speak, write, and understand the English Language
- Successful completion of High School/GED/Equivalency, or higher
- FAA Class 2 Medical Certificate, or higher; and EASA Class 1 Medical Certificate (EASA program)¹
- Sufficient funds to cover training and living expenses for the duration of the program (verification must be provided with registration paperwork)
- In addition, non-native English speakers must submit one of the following:
 - Evidence of having completed at least four years of high school level or one year of university level English classes; or
 - A certified copy of ICAO test results showing a minimum proficiency level of 4; or
 - A recognized English language proficiency test with equivalent scoring results

Instrument Rating Program	Successful completion of Private Pilot Program
Commercial Pilot Program	Successful completion of Private Pilot Program
Flight Instructor	Successful completion of Commercial Pilot Program
Flight Instructor/ Instrument	Successful completion of Commercial Pilot Program; and a valid Instrument Rating – Rotorcraft Helicopter
Turbine Transition	Successful completion of Private Pilot Program

¹ If a Medical Certificate is revoked by regulatory authorities, Bristow Academy will terminate training.
